An excerpt from The University of Cambridge International Examinations - Conduct of examination 2011, “The calculator must not be able to *manipulate algebra*, it must be purely numerical integration / differentiation”.

Calculator with any of the following facilities are **prohibited**, unless stated otherwise in the syllabus:

• Graphic display	• Data banks	• Dictionaries	• Language translators	• Retrieval or manipulation of text of formulae
• QWERTY keyboard	• Built-in symbolic algebraic manipulation	• Symbolic differentiation or integration	• Capability of remote communication with other machines	

CIE will regard the use of any such calculator as malpractice.
